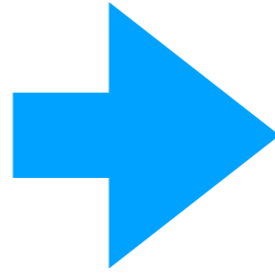

# Here's how:

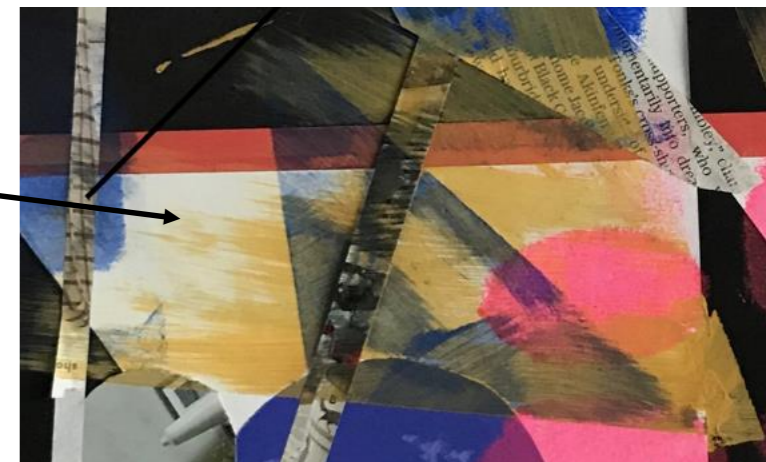
Start with A3 black paper

Cut out and stick on triangle shapes  
from a variety of  
different papers eg; newspaper, plain  
paper, pre-painted paper

Mask off different areas

Use a sponge to LIGHTLY apply paint

Add more strips cut on paper cutter



Lo: Develop several pieces of work from the same collage:

**1. Add paint to your original (see Demo)**

**2. Mix the colour and apply it thinly**

**3. Then add some shapes (they are circles in the example but you should use shapes that are on the photo eg : triangles, squares)**

**For this use: painted or oil pastel paper**

On the photocopy repeat the process of adding paper shapes, then strips of paper then paint. You could cut this in half so you have 2 or 4 different images.

# What else can you do to develop your work?

- More ink drawings
- Another collage
- White pencil on black card
- Lino print
- Collage photos
- Monoprinting



# Taking photos

Take 5 photos each of parts of MEA that show lines, angles, repeating patterns.

Choose an unusual viewpoint eg: worms eye, birds eye and *try* to take different ones to each other

Photograph your name BEFORE you take your photos.



# Using laptops/photoshop

- **Select areas** from 8 different photographs
- **Arrange them** on 2 powerpoint slides (4 per page). Print.
- **Add filters** to 2/3 of the selected photos to change the way they look. Save and print. Add to your display board.

# Writing on your board

- Use the annotation sheets to answer questions about your work
- Say what went well
- Say what you would improve
- Say how it will be included in your final piece

Write in white pencil or on white paper and stick it on your board
