What does the course involve?

You will study a mixture of coursework and exam based units throughout the two year course. You will also complete an externally assessed research project based on a contemporary issue in the sector. You will study a number of different units including Human Lifespan Development where you will learn the physical, intellectual, emotional and social development across the human lifespan and the factors affecting development and the effects of ageing. You will also explore what it is like to work in the health and social care sector, including the role and responsibilities of workers and organisations.

Entry requirements

- Minimum of five GCSE grades 9-4 (or A*-C) including either English or Maths
