What does the course involve?

The course involves 10 units that range in topics from fitness testing and sports leadership to injury management. 2 of the 10 units are externally assessed exams which are mandatory units and have to be passed in order to pass the course. Lessons are split between practical sessions and theory lessons. The course also has weekly visits to coach at a local primary school and elite football coaching sessions with various Manchester United FC coaches, including the club's chief scout Marcel Bout.

Entry requirements

- GCSE or equivalent Level 2 Pass in PE/Sport
- Grade 4 or above in 5 GCSEs including English and Maths
