Key Changes to the Year 9 Behaviour Policy

Your child now approaches the most important stage so far in their school life. For us to make sure they have the very best changes and secure a fantastic future, we would like to inform you of some key changes we are making to our behaviour policy for Year 9 from Monday 24th June.

Our behaviour policy has three clear rules:

- 1) Be Safe. Follow the instructions of the MEA staff.
- 2) Be Respectful. Respect the building and everyone in it.
- 3) Be Ready. Put your learning first.

Our behaviour system is based around students making correct choices and supporting those who may struggle at times. For those who make the wrong choices the following things will now happen:

- Students will be given a warning from their teacher explaining how they are not meeting our expectations linked to the rules above.
- If students do not make the correct choices following the warning, they will be removed from the lesson and taken to another classroom.
- Parents will then be contacted and invited in for a meeting on the same day.
- Students will complete a one-hour detention that day after school.

The vast majority of our Year 9 students follow our behaviour policy and are a credit to you and to the Academy. The students who consistently make the right choices will not be affected by the changes to our behaviour system.

We know that children thrive best when schools and parents work in partnership. With this in mind, please discuss these changes with your child so they are clear on our high expectations as to how to achieve a Fantastic Future.
